Internship Program maker Talks

InScience is the Dutch film festival for science film. The program consists of the best science films released worldwide in the past year, international top scientists who share the latest scientific findings as well as filmmakers who talk about their work, interactive programs in which visitors themselves take on the role of a scientist, and an extensive education program.

The diverse film program, a large festival audience and more than 200 national and international scientists as well as film professionals, directors and film producers transform Nijmegen into a meeting place for science, film, and society during InScience.

Position - Intern Program maker Talks

As an Intern Program maker you will assist with the Talks program around the films; you will learn which questions to ask for a good program; you will write to scientists and filmmakers and invite them to the festival; you will think of creative ways to get the audience not only to listen, but to participate in and experience science; you will make sure that the Talks program of InScience runs smoothly and is appealing to the audience; and you assist the coordinator of your department.

Interns at InScience are a core part of the organization. You are part of a small team, you get an insider's view into the organization of a film festival and meet people from the entire field.

Profile

/ You are studying or have just graduated from an MBO- HBO- or WO-program.

/ Your understanding of the English language is excellent (both orally and in writing);

/ You are creative, meticulous, stress-resistant and have no problem making phone calls to the speakers you invite to the festival.

/ You have a good basic knowledge of various scientific disciplines and have a broad interest into societal topics.

/ You work in a structured and organized manner;

/ You are independent and can also work well in a team;

/ Living in or around Nijmegen is an advantage.

Time period

The internship runs from November 2022 to March 2023. The duration is 16-24 hours per week.

You work fulltime in the two weeks before the festival and you must be available on all days of the festival (15th to 19th of March). There is a possibility to negotiate about the time period as well your hours. You will receive an internship fee of 150 euros per month.
